### GRANADA AIRPORT

Taxi: A taxi from the airport to the city center costs around 30€.

Bus: After the arrival of a flight there is usually a bus to the city center. The company is ALSA. It costs 3€.

### MALAGA AIRPORT

Bus: There is a direct bus from Malaga Airport to Granada. [Info](#) It costs around 12€. Once in Granada you can use a taxi to get to the city center or the city bus (1,40€) number 33 or 21.

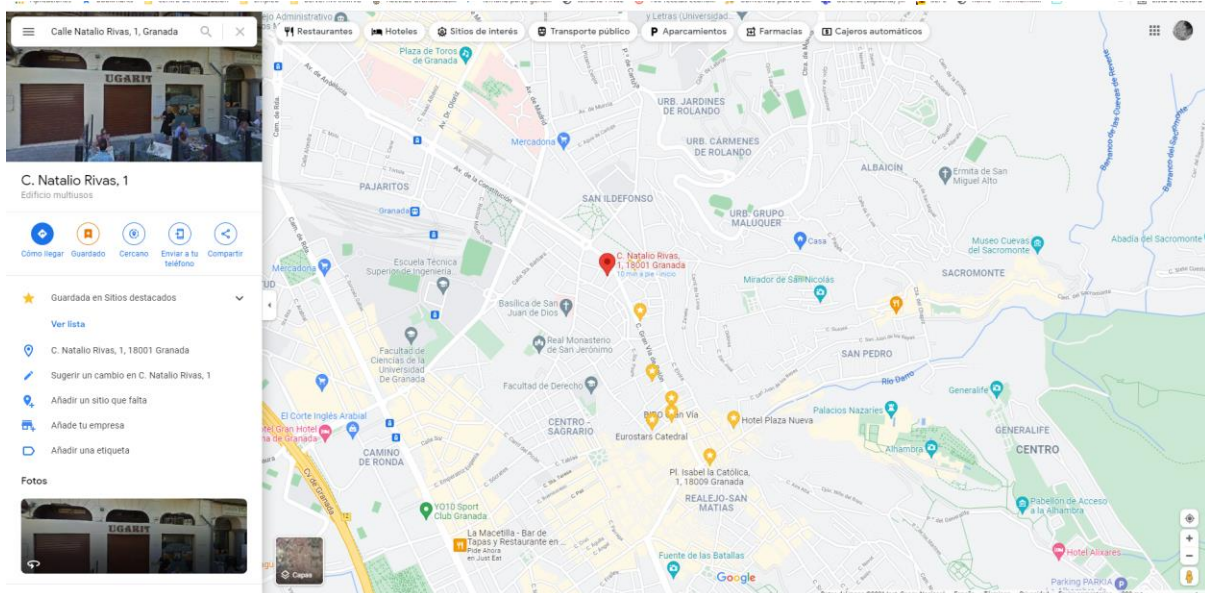

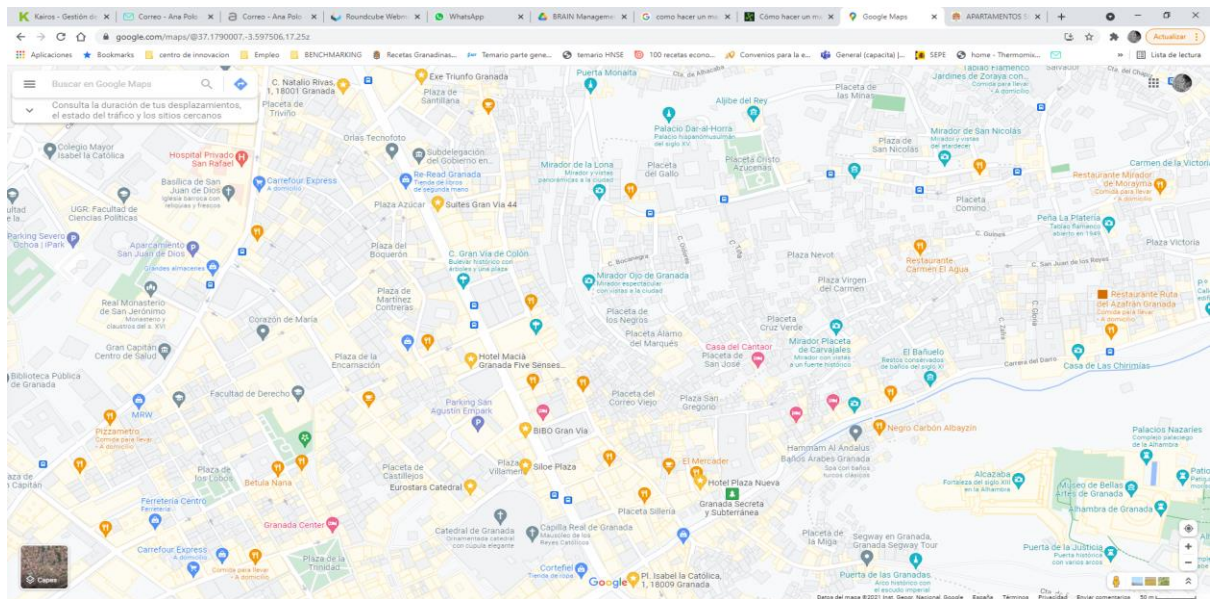

### What to know about Spain before travel

**SIM card / Internet:** you can buy a prepaid card to access the Internet on your travels. You can find the main telephone operators in any shopping center or in the city center. EU member states currently enjoy roaming without additional charges throughout the EU.

**Voltage and plugs:** The voltage is 220V, Schuko (Type F) or Europlug (Type C) plugs are used. [My recommendation takes a universal plug adapter.](#)

**Security:** Spain in general is a safe country. Be careful with pickpockets in the center of big cities and on public transport, especially in the subway. Also use common sense to avoid getting into trouble.

**Lunch & Dinner Time:** later than the rest of Europe.

- Lunch: 14h-15 (2pm to 4pm) till 16h in some places...
- Dinner: 21h-22h (9pm to 10pm) or later on weekends and touristic places.

### VISA:

- Citizens within the European Union, Switzerland, Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein only need a valid National Identity Document or passport.
- The United Kingdom and Ireland do not belong to the Schengen area and require a passport. In the case of a minor and traveling with the DNI, it must be accompanied by a parental permission.

**Tourist or private trips:** In these cases, the presentation of any of the following documents may be required:

- Document justifying the lodging establishment or letter of invitation from a private individual, if he / she is staying at his / her home, issued by the Police Station corresponding to his / her place of residence.
- **IMPORTANT:** In no case, the invitation letter will replace the accreditation by the foreigner of the other requirements for entry.
- Confirmation of the reservation of an organized trip, with the itinerary.
- Return ticket or tourist circuit



### Basic vocabulary for traveling

Basic vocabulary to travel to Spain. Spanish love when a foreigner tries to speak their language.

- Hi/ Hello: **Hola**
- Good Morning: **Buenos días**
- Good afternoon: **Buenas tardes**
- Good night: **Buenas noches**
- Goodbye: **adiós**
- See you later: **Hasta luego** (In Spain you'll hear: see you later, even if you will never see this person again in your life).
- Thank you: **Gracias**
- Please: **por favor**
- I don't speak your language, I speak English: **No hablo tu idioma, hablo inglés.**
- Excuse me, do you know how to get to...? **Disculpe, sabe cómo llegar a...**
- Where is it?: **dónde está...?**
- A beer? please ;): **una cerveza, por favor. Una caña** (small beer)
- How much is it? : **Cuánto es esto?**
- How much does it cost? : **Cuánto cuesta esto?**
- I don't understand: **No entiendo or no te entiendo.**
